5	as amended by section 406 of this Act, is further amended
6	by adding at the end the following new section:
7	"SEC. 435. MARITIME SECURITY CAPABILITIES ASSESS-
8	MENTS.
9	"(a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after
10	the date of the enactment of this section and annually
11	thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to the Committee
12	on Homeland Security of the House of Representatives
13	and the Committee on Homeland Security and Govern-
14	mental Affairs of the Senate a report on the following:
15	"(1) The number and type of maritime assets
16	and number of personnel assigned to each Transit

1	Zone at any time in the immediately preceding one
2	year period.
3	"(2) The number of maritime security enforce-
4	ment actions the Department has identified in each
5	Transit Zone in the immediately preceding one year
6	period but was unable to execute due to resource
7	constraints.
8	"(3) An assessment of the number and type of
9	maritime assets and number of personnel required to
10	execute actions on all identified maritime security
11	enforcement actions in each Transit Zone.
12	"(b) Exception.—The requirement for each report
13	under this section to contain information for the imme-
14	diately preceding one year period shall not apply to the
15	first such report.".
16	(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
