

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2825
OFFERED BY MR. GALLAGHER OF WISCONSIN**

At the end of subtitle A of title V, add the following:

1 **SEC. 504. TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION**
2 **EFFICIENCY.**

3 (a) **EFFICIENCY REVIEW.**—Not later than 270 days
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Adminis-
5 trator of the Transportation Security Administration shall
6 conduct and complete a comprehensive, agency-wide effi-
7 ciency review of the Administration to identify and effec-
8 tuate spending reductions and administrative savings
9 through the streamlining or restructuring of Administra-
10 tion divisions to make the Administration more efficient.
11 In carrying out the review under this section, the Adminis-
12 trator shall consider each of the following:

13 (1) The elimination of any unnecessarily dupli-
14 cative or overlapping programs and initiatives that
15 can be streamlined.

16 (2) The elimination of any unnecessary or obso-
17 lete rules, regulations, directives, or procedures.

18 (3) The reduction in overall operating expenses
19 of the Administration, including costs associated

1 with the number of personnel, as a direct result of
2 efficiencies gained through the implementation of
3 risk-based screening or through any other means as
4 determined by the Administrator.

5 (4) Any other matters the Administrator deter-
6 mines are appropriate.

7 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 30 days
8 after the completion of the efficiency review required
9 under subsection (a), the Administrator of the Transpor-
10 tation Security Administration shall report to the Com-
11 mittee on Homeland Security of the House of Representa-
12 tives and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
13 Transportation of the Senate on the results and cost sav-
14 ings expected to be achieved through such efficiency re-
15 view.
