

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2825
OFFERED BY MR. ROGERS OF ALABAMA**

In section 521, add at the end the following:

1 (d) BRIEFING TO CONGRESS.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
3 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Ad-
4 ministrator of the Transportation Security Adminis-
5 tration shall brief the Committee on Homeland Se-
6 curity of the House of Representatives and the Com-
7 mittee on Homeland Security and Governmental Af-
8 fairs and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
9 Transportation of the Senate on the state of explo-
10 sives detection canine production and training in the
11 United States.

12 (2) CONTENTS.—The briefing required under
13 paragraph (1) shall include the following:

14 (A) An analysis of the steps the Transpor-
15 tation Security Administration may take to fos-
16 ter additional production of explosives detection
17 canines in the United States by the private sec-
18 tor.

1 (B) Perspectives from current explosives
2 detection canine industry stakeholders regard-
3 ing the impact of the Administration's procure-
4 ment model on business considerations.

5 (C) An analysis regarding whether the Ad-
6 ministration effectively communicates canine
7 training guidelines and testing methodology to
8 the private sector.

9 (D) The extent to which physical capacity
10 limitations at current Administration-operated
11 sites hinder the operations of either the Admin-
12 istration or industry.
