

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2825
OFFERED BY MISS RICE OF NEW YORK**

At the end of title V, insert the following:

1 **Subtitle H—Maintenance of**
2 **Security-Related Technology**

3 **SEC. 591. MAINTENANCE OF SECURITY-RELATED TECH-**
4 **NOLOGY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title XVI of the Homeland Secu-
6 rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 561 et seq.) is amended by
7 adding at the end the following new subtitle:

8 **“Subtitle C—Maintenance of**
9 **Security-Related Technology**

10 **“SEC. 1621. MAINTENANCE VALIDATION AND OVERSIGHT.**

11 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after
12 the date of the enactment of this subtitle, the Adminis-
13 trator shall develop and implement a preventive mainte-
14 nance validation process for security-related technology
15 deployed to airports.

16 “(b) MAINTENANCE BY ADMINISTRATION PER-
17 SONNEL AT AIRPORTS.—For maintenance to be carried
18 out by Administration personnel at airports, the process
19 referred to in subsection (a) shall include the following:

1 “(1) Guidance to Administration personnel at
2 airports specifying how to conduct and document
3 preventive maintenance actions.

4 “(2) Mechanisms for the Administrator to
5 verify compliance with the guidance issued pursuant
6 to paragraph (1).

7 “(c) MAINTENANCE BY CONTRACTORS AT AIR-
8 PORTS.—For maintenance to be carried by a contractor
9 at airports, the process referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 require the following:

11 “(1) Provision of monthly preventative mainte-
12 nance schedules to appropriate Administration per-
13 sonnel at each airport that includes information on
14 each action to be completed by contractor.

15 “(2) Notification to appropriate Administration
16 personnel at each airport when maintenance action
17 is completed by a contractor.

18 “(3) A process for independent validation by a
19 third party of contractor maintenance.

20 “(d) PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE.—The Ad-
21 ministrators shall require maintenance contracts for secu-
22 rity-related technology deployed to airports to include pen-
23 alties for noncompliance when it is determined that either
24 preventive or corrective maintenance has not been com-

1 pleted according to contractual requirements and manu-
2 facturers' specifications.”.

3 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
4 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is amended by in-
5 serting after the item relating to section 1616 the fol-
6 lowing:

“Subtitle C—Maintenance of Security-Related Technology

“Sec. 1621. Maintenance validation and oversight.”.
