Amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 2825 Offered by Mrs. Watson Coleman of New Jersey

At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following:

1 SEC. 529. INNOVATION TASK FORCE.

(a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Transportation Security Administration may establish a task
force to collaborate with air carriers, airport operators,
and other aviation security stakeholders to foster the pursuit of innovations in aviation security prior to the acquisition process.

8 (b) ACTIVITIES.—The task force authorized under 9 subsection (a) may conduct activities designed to identify 10 and develop an innovative technology or capability with the 11 potential of enhancing aviation security, including—

(1) conducting a field demonstration of such a
technology or capability in the airport environment;
(2) gathering performance data from such a
demonstration to inform the acquisition process; and
(3) provide funding and promoting efforts to
enable participation in a demonstration by a small

2	not have adequate resources to participate.
3	(c) COMPOSITION.—The task force authorized under
4	subsection (a) shall be—
5	(1) chaired by the Administrator of the Trans-
6	portation Security Administration's designee; and
7	(2) comprised of representatives appointed by
8	the Administrator, in consultation with the Chair-
9	person of the Aviation Security Advisory Committee
10	(established pursuant to section 44936 of title 49,
11	United States Code), from appropriate stakeholders
12	from—
13	(A) within the Administration;
14	(B) air carriers;
15	(C) airport operators;
16	(D) other aviation security stakeholders;
17	and
18	(E) as appropriate, the Science and Tech-
19	nology Directorate of the Department of Home-
20	land Security and any other appropriate compo-
21	nent of the Department.
22	(d) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
23	tion shall require the Administrator of the Transportation
24	Security Administration to acquire an innovative tech-
25	nology or emerging security capability.

(e) NON-APPLICABILITY OF FACA.—The Federal
 Advisory Committee Act (5 U.S.C. App.) shall not apply
 to the task force authorized under subsection (a).
