

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1639**

Add at the end the following:

1           (d) INSPECTOR GENERAL REVIEW.—Not later than  
2 120 days after the Commissioner of U.S. Customs and  
3 Border Protection develops a workload staffing model pur-  
4 suant to subsection (a), the Inspector General of the De-  
5 partment of Homeland Security shall review such model  
6 and provide feedback to the Secretary of Homeland Secu-  
7 rity and the Committee on Homeland Security of the  
8 House of Representatives and the Committee on Home-  
9 land Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate re-  
10 garding the degree to which such model is responsive to  
11 Inspector General recommendations, including rec-  
12 ommendations from the Inspector General’s February  
13 2019 audit, and as appropriate, any further recommenda-  
14 tions to improve such model.
