- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "CISA Director Reform
- 5 Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. CISA DIRECTOR TERM LIMITATION.

- 2 (a) In General.—Paragraph (1) of section 2202(b)
- 3 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 652(b))
- 4 is amended by inserting at the end the following new sen-
- 5 tence: "Each Director shall serve for a term of five
- 6 years.".
- 7 (b) Transition Rules.—The amendment made by
- 8 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act and apply beginning—
- 10 (1) with the confirmation of the new Director
- of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Protection
- 12 Agency of the Department of Homeland Security, or
- 13 (2) on January 1, 2021,
- 14 whichever comes first.
