 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Supporting Research
- 5 and Development for First Responders Act".

1SEC. 2. NATIONAL URBAN SECURITY TECHNOLOGY LAB-2ORATORY.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of the Homeland Secu4 rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 181 et seq.) is amended by
5 adding at the end the following new section:

6 "SEC. 322. NATIONAL URBAN SECURITY TECHNOLOGY LAB7 ORATORY.

8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, acting through 9 the Under Secretary for Science and Technology, shall designate the laboratory described in subsection (b) as an 10 11 additional laboratory pursuant to the authority under section 308(c)(2). Such laboratory shall be used to test and 12 13 evaluate emerging technologies and conduct research and development to assist emergency response providers in 14 preparing for, and protecting against, threats of terrorism. 15

16 "(b) LABORATORY DESCRIBED.—The laboratory de-17 scribed in this subsection is the laboratory—

18 "(1) known, as of the date of the enactment of
19 this section, as the National Urban Security Tech20 nology Laboratory; and

21 "(2) transferred to the Department pursuant to
22 section 303(1)(E).

23 "(c) LABORATORY ACTIVITIES.—The National Urban
24 Security Technology Laboratory shall—

25 "(1) conduct tests, evaluations, and assess26 ments of current and emerging technologies, includ-

ing, as appropriate, the cybersecurity of such tech nologies that can connect to the internet, for emer gency response providers;

4 "(2) act as a technical advisor to emergency re5 sponse providers; and

6 "(3) carry out other such activities as the Sec7 retary determines appropriate.

8 "(d) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec9 tion may be construed as affecting in any manner the au10 thorities or responsibilities of the Countering Weapons of
11 Mass Destruction Office of the Department.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
in section 1(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is
amended by inserting after the item relating to section
321 the following new item:

"Sec. 322. National Urban Security Technology Laboratory.".
