12	(2) in subparagraph (H), by striking the period

14	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-

16	"(I) identify and integrate the needs of

9	mental Affairs of the Senate a report describing the ef
10	forts the Department has undertaken to review and incor
11	porate feedback from organizations representing the needs
