Amendments should be pre-filed by emailing a searchable electronic PDF copy of the amendment (Office of the Legislative Counsel version preferred) by the deadline to CHS.Amendments@mail.house.gov. Each amendment should be saved as a single file. The email should include the following: author of the amendment; measure amending; and, where possible, the section being amended. Amendments pre-filed with the Clerk by the deadline will be consolidated on a roster and considered prior to amendments offered outside the roster process at the markup.

If offering amendments at the markup outside the roster process, please provide **60 copies** and the attached form to the Clerk at the Desk.
