

Chris Jones, President/CEO Biographical Information

Chris Jones is Middle Tennessee Electric's President and just the fifth CEO in the cooperative's 89-year history. A 26-year veteran of MTE, he is a graduate of the University of Tennessee, where he earned his degree in communications.

Chris serves MTE members, and the community in general, through several avenues. He is a board member of United Communications and the Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association, past chair of both the Rutherford County Chamber of Commerce and the Williamson County Chamber of Commerce, chair of Destination Rutherford, and a board member of the Tennessee Chamber of Commerce. Chris served on the Tennessee Nuclear Energy Advisory Council as the state's utilities representative; this council was created by Governor Lee to position the state as a national leader for nuclear energy innovation and advancement.

Chris lives in Murfreesboro with his wife, Bonita, who is a retired teacher. They have two grown daughters, Cayln (pronounced Kay•lin) and Chrisln (pronounced Chris•lin).
