

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**  
**TO H.R. 275**  
**OFFERED BY MS. GREENE OF GEORGIA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Special Interest Alien  
3 Reporting Act of 2025”.

**4 SEC. 2. PUBLICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**  
**5 SECURITY OF THE NUMBER OF SPECIAL IN-**  
**6 TEREST ALIENS ENCOUNTERED.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than the seventh day of  
8 each month beginning with the first full month that begins  
9 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary  
10 of Homeland Security shall publish on a publicly available  
11 webpage of the Department of Homeland Security and  
12 submit to the Committee on Homeland Security of the  
13 House of Representatives and the Committee on Home-  
14 land Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a  
15 report on the total number, and an identification of the  
16 nationalities or countries of last habitual residence, of spe-  
17 cial interest aliens encountered by the Department during

1 the immediately preceding month. Each such report shall  
2 also include the following:

3 (1) Such number disaggregated by geographic  
4 regions of such encounters.

5 (2) Specifications relating to whether such en-  
6 counters were made at land, air, or sea ports of  
7 entry, between ports of entry, or in the interior of  
8 the United States.

9 (3) Identification of any such nationalities or  
10 countries of last habitual residence that are covered  
11 nations.

12 (b) INCLUSION.—The first report required under sub-  
13 section (a) shall also include the matters described in such  
14 subsection for the time period from January 20, 2021,  
15 through January 19, 2025.

16 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

17 (1) ALIEN.—The term “alien” has the meaning  
18 given such term in section 101 of the Immigration  
19 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101).

20 (2) COVERED NATION.—The term “covered na-  
21 tion” has the meaning given such term in section  
22 4872(d)(2) of title 10, United States Code.

23 (3) SPECIAL INTEREST ALIEN.—The term “spe-  
24 cial interest alien” means an alien who, based on an  
25 analysis of travel patterns, potentially poses a na-

1 tional security risk to the United States or its inter-  
2 ests.
