

Alicia "Ali" Hopper is a nationally recognized expert in human trafficking and the President of *GUARD Against Trafficking*, a nonprofit she co-founded to combat exploitation through innovative research, education and advocacy. She authored Florida's landmark *Anti-Grooming Bill*, now used as model language in multiple states.

Ali has testified before Congress on child trafficking and has delivered numerous congressional briefings on human trafficking. Ali conducts on-the-ground research in the U.S., Mexico, Central and South America. This includes interviews with human traffickers who have been incarcerated in the U.S. and abroad. She has trained INTERPOL in South America, U.S. law enforcement, and policymakers across multiple states and countries.

A frequent voice in national media, Ali continues to shape public awareness and drive forward policies that protect children and combat trafficking nationwide.

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
