## NOTICE OF SUBCOMMITTEE MARKUP

### TIME CHANGE

Dear Subcommittee Member:

On Thursday, March 7, 2024, the Subcommittee on Counterterrorism, Law Enforcement, and Intelligence will hold a markup to consider the following measures:

H.R. 7443, (Mr. Pfluger) To authorize a dedicated transnational repression office within the Department of Homeland Security's Homeland Security Investigations to analyze and monitor transnational repression and related terrorism threats and require Homeland Security Investigations to take actions to prevent transnational repression;

H.R. 7433, (Mr. D'Esposito) To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish a transnational repression hotline and conduct a transnational repression public service announcement campaign, and for other purposes;

H.R. 7439, (Mr. Magaziner) To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to require the Secretary of Homeland Security to prioritize strengthening of State and local law enforcement capabilities to combat transnational repression and related terrorism threats, and for other purposes.

The markup originally scheduled for 3:00 p.m. EST in 310 Cannon House Office Building **will now take place at 2:30 p.m. EST in 310 Cannon House Office Building. The Chair of the Subcommittee with concurrence of the Ranking Minority Member has determined that there is good cause to begin the meeting sooner than scheduled (Committee Rule V(A)(2)(a)).**
