The Subcommittee on Counterterrorism and Intelligence will meet in open markup session on Thursday, May 14, 2026, at 3:00 p.m. EDT, in 310 Cannon to consider the following measures:

H.R. 7443, (Mr. Pfluger) the “I&A Mission Reorientation Act of 2026”;

H.R. 7764, (Mr. Evans of CO) the “National Threat Evaluation and Reporting Program Reassignment and Funding Reform Act of 2026”;

H.R. 7574, (Mr. Evans of CO) the “ELO Realignment and Strategic Engagement Reform Act of 2026”;

H.R. 8142 (Mr. Mackenzie) the “Special Events Program Alignment Act of 2026”;

H.R. 7448, (Ms. Pou) the “Modernizing and Improving the National Terrorism Advisory System Act of 2026”;

H.R. 7427, (Mr. Goldman) the “Securing Access from Foreign Entities Visiting Internal Sites in the States Act” or “SAFE VISITS Act”; and

H.R. 7436, (Mr. Magaziner) the “Department of Homeland Security Intelligence and Analysis Training Act”

Members are encouraged to prefile their amendments with the Clerk of the Committee **by no later than 3:00 p.m. EDT on Wednesday, May 13, 2026**, so that they may be consolidated onto a roster. Amendments should be pre-filed by emailing a searchable electronic PDF copy of the amendment (Office of the Legislative Counsel version preferred) by the deadline to CHS.Amendments@mail.house.gov. Each amendment should be saved as a single file. The email should include the following: author of the amendment; measure amending; and, where possible, the section being amended. Amendments pre-filed with the Clerk by the deadline will be consolidated on a roster and considered prior to amendments offered outside the roster process at the markup.

If offering amendments at the markup outside the roster process, please provide **20 copies and the attached form** to the Clerk at the Desk.
