Chief Murphy is a resident of Erlanger and was raised in the Northern Kentucky area, where he graduated from Boone County HS in 1987. He went on to Wilmington College, located in Wilmington OH and graduated in 1991 with a BA majoring in Criminal Justice and Accounting. Kevin worked a short time as an Accounting Administrator for a small company in Cincinnati before was hired as a patrol officer for the Airport Police in 1992 and was valedictorian of Police Basic Training class 218. While assigned to the Patrol Section, Kevin served as a bike officer, Field Training Officer and eventually a Sergeant. He was promoted to Lieutenant in 1999 and commanded the Investigation and the Administration Sections. In April of 2005, Kevin was selected as the Police Chief. Kevin served on the Board of Directors of Airport Law Enforcement Agency Network (ALEAN) for 4 years, before being elected as 2<sup>nd</sup> VP in 2011 and President in 2013. He served as the Professional Standards Committee Chairperson for the Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police (KACP) and President of the Northern Kentucky Police Chief's Association. Kevin is a graduate of the 201<sup>st</sup> class of the FBI National Academy, the US Secret Service Dignitary Protection Class and the KY Department of Criminal Justice Training (DOCJT) School of Strategic Leadership. Kevin has served as the Airport Security Coordinator for CVG. Kevin served as the Police Chief Representative for 2 sessions of the TSA –National Explosive Detection Canine Team Program (NEDCTP) Quality Action Team (QAT).
