Timothy J. Scott is the Chief Security Officer & Corporate Director of Emergency Services & Security (ES&S) for The Dow Chemical Company, and a member of Dow's Corporate Crisis Management Team.

Scott served on the executive committee of the Chemical Sector Coordinating Council of the Department of Homeland Security, was a member of the inaugural National Maritime Security Advisory Committee, and co-chaired a Chemical Sector Case Study on Information Sharing sponsored by the National Infrastructure Advisory Council. Scott has testified as a subject matter expert before committees of both the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate, and currently serves on the Advisory Board of the International Center for Chemical Safety & Security and as a member of the G8 Global Partnership Sub-Working Group on Chemical Security.

In 2007 Scott was named by Security Magazine as one of the 25 most influential security executives in the U.S.; and was a finalist for the Leadership Excellence Award sponsored by the Harvard Business Review and the United States Naval Academy's Stockdale Center for Ethical Leadership.

Scott joined Dow in 1979 and progressed through a number of assignments in public relations, emergency services and security. Before joining Dow Scott was an officer in the U. S. Navy.
