JR Ramirez Biography

J.R. Ramirez of La Pryor, Texas, is general manager of Chaparrosa Ranch (Flying B Ranches), a commercial cow-calf operation also raising purebred Beefmasters and registered Quarter Horses with an extensive wildlife management program. He is also involved in the other Flying B Ranches operations which are Rancho del Cielo near Kent, and Rancho Margaritas near Múzquiz, Coahuila, Mexico. His family has been ranching in Zapata County since 1932 on the Circle 17 Ranch and he is part of the fifth generation involved in the operation. He worked on King Ranch for 15 years in various positions, eventually serving as cattle area manager.
