



**Louis Koumoutsos**

Chief Security Officer Joseph Dunne appointed Louis Koumoutsos as the Port Authority Police Chief of the Department in May of 2013. The 21 Year veteran of the Department has supervised all diverse Port Authority Police Commands throughout his illustrious career. The former Commanding Officer of the PATH Command, Mr. Koumoutsos was officially installed as the Departments highest-ranking officer, currently holding the position of Four Star Chief.

Chief Koumoutsos, 49, joined the Port Authority Police Department in April of 1993, and began his career on patrol at Newark Liberty International Airport. He was promoted to Sergeant in January of 2003, Lieutenant in June of 2007, Captain in July of 2008, and Inspector in June of 2012.

Before being appointed Chief of the Department, while serving as the Commanding Officer of the PATH Command, Chief Koumoutsos was instrumental in leading the police recovery operations following Hurricane Sandy. His efforts directly facilitated the reinstatement of PATH Service to the region and the continuity of the security to the system.

Before appointment to the rank of Inspector, Chief Koumoutsos served as the Commanding Officer of the Port Authority Police Office of Emergency Management. As the Office of Emergency Management Captain, he was responsible for the implementation of numerous counter terrorism patrol initiatives, the acquisition of advanced specialized CBRNE instrumentation, and the development of facility emergency response plans and procedures.

Prior to the appointment to the rank of Captain, Chief Koumoutsos acted as a Police Lieutenant at all three New York City Major Metropolitan Airports, where he acted as Incident Commander during numerous dignitary and presidential arrivals and departures necessitating a robust, coordinated Inter-Agency Security Deployment Strategies.

Chief Koumoutsos played a pivotal role in the 9/11 Attack response, recovery, and relief efforts at the World Trade Center site. In addition, he has acted as the Supervising Court Administrative liaison within the New Jersey Justice System.

Chief Koumoutsos holds a Bachelors Degree from Farleigh Dickenson University in Public Administration, is a Graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy, The Israeli Special Forces Administrative Training Academy, and the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Emergency Preparedness Training Program.

Mr. Koumoutsos is an Archon of the Greek Orthodox Church, in which he is recognized as a community leader and youth mentor. He is an elected member of the St. George Greek Orthodox Church of Ocean Township, New Jersey.
