

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3
OFFERED BY MR. BEN RAY LUJÁN OF NEW
MEXICO

At the end of the bill, insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 9. ENERGY SECURITY.

2 This Act shall not take effect until the President de-
3 termines that any crude oil and bitumen transported by
4 the Keystone XL pipeline, and all refined petroleum prod-
5 ucts whose origin was via importation of crude oil or bitu-
6 men by the Keystone XL pipeline, will be entered into do-
7 mestic commerce for use as a fuel, or for the manufacture
8 of another product, in the United States, except in the
9 following situations:

10 (1) Where the President determines that pro-
11 viding an exception is in the national interest be-
12 cause it—

13 (A) will not lead to an increase in domestic
14 consumption of crude oil or refined petroleum
15 products obtained from countries hostile to
16 United States interests or with political and
17 economic instability that compromises energy
18 supply security;

1 (B) will not lead to higher costs to refiners
2 who purchase the crude oil than such refiners
3 would otherwise have to pay for crude oil; and

4 (C) will not lead to higher gasoline costs to
5 consumers than consumers would otherwise
6 have to pay.

7 (2) Where an exchange of crude oil or refined
8 product provides for no net loss of crude oil or re-
9 fined product consumed domestically.

10 (3) Where providing an exception is necessary
11 under the Constitution, a law, or an international
12 agreement.
