

**H.R. 6, AS AMENDED BY THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON
ENERGY AND POWER ON APRIL 9, 2014**

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Domestic Prosperity
3 and Global Freedom Act”.

4 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.

5 Section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.
6 717b(c)) is amended—

7 (1) by inserting “(1)” before “ For purposes”;

8 (2) by striking “a nation with which there is in
9 effect a free trade agreement requiring national
10 treatment for trade in natural gas” and inserting “a
11 World Trade Organization member nation”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(2) For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘World
14 Trade Organization member nation’ means a country de-
15 scribed in section 2(10) of the Uruguay Round Agree-
16 ments Act (19 U.S.C. 3501(10)).”.

17 SEC. 3. PENDING APPLICATIONS.

18 Any application for authorization to export natural
19 gas under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C.
20 717b) for which a notice has been published in the Federal

1 Register before March 6, 2014, shall be granted without
2 modification or delay.

3 **SEC. 4. PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF EXPORT DESTINATIONS.**

4 Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717b)
5 is amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(g) PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF LNG EXPORT DES-
7 TINATIONS.—As a condition for approval of any authoriza-
8 tion to export LNG, the Secretary of Energy shall require
9 the applicant to publicly disclose the specific destination
10 or destinations of any such authorized LNG exports.”.
