Page and line numbers refer to BLACKB__028 April 10, 2015

Page 2, strike lines 2 through 8, and insert the following:

1 (1) protect consumers from identity theft, eco-
2 nomic loss or economic harm, and financial fraud by
3 establishing strong and uniform national data secu-
4 rity standards for each person engaged in interstate
5 commerce that owns or possess data containing per-
6 sonal information and data breach notification
7 standards for electronic data in interstate commerce
8 while minimizing State law burdens that may sub-
9 stantially affect interstate commerce; and

Page 2, line15, strike “in electronic form”.

Page 28, after line 21, insert the following new paragraph:

10 (14) REASONABLE SECURITY MEASURES AND
11 PRACTICES.—The term “reasonable security meas-
12 ures and practices” means security standards that
13 incorporate the following:

1 (A) Transparency regarding collection, use,
2 sale, and maintenance of personal information.

3 (B) Identification of the individual respon-
4 sible for the overall management of the security
5 policy.

6 (C) A process for identifying any reason-
7 ably foreseeable vulnerabilities.

8 (D) A process for quickly responding to
9 identified vulnerabilities.

10 (E) A process for the disposal of electronic
11 data in a way that protects the consumer's pri-
12 vacy.

13 (F) A process for the disposal of paper
14 data in a way that protects the consumer's pri-
15 vacy.
