12 down as described in subclause (I);

14 “(iii) a list of the congressional inves-  
15 tigation of the Commission that were  
16 pending on the last day of such quarter (or  
17 more frequent period, as the case may be)  
18 and the cost of such investigations, individ-  
19 ually and in the aggregate;

Page 7, after line 11, insert the following:

20 “(5) GAO AUDIT.—Not less frequently than  
21 every 6 months, the Comptroller General of the  
22 United States shall audit the cost estimates provided

1 by the Commission under paragraph (2)(D)(iii) dur-  
2 ing the preceding 6-month period.
