7 ((10) Not later than 48 hours before the time when an order, decision, report, or action is made or taken pur-8 9 suant to delegation under paragraph (1), such order, decision, report, or action shall be identified and briefly de-10 11 scribed on the Internet website of the Commission, unless the authority to which the delegation is made for good 12 cause finds that such identification and description are 13 14 likely to lead to a result described in a paragraph of sec-15 tion 552b(c) of title 5, United States Code. Identification and description pursuant to this paragraph shall not con-16 stitute 'agency action' as defined in section 551 of title 17

5, United States Code. This paragraph shall not apply 1 2 with respect to an order, decision, report, or action that— 3 "(A) does not receive a delegated authority 4 number pursuant to the procedures of the Commis-5 sion; "(B) is made or taken on authority delegated to 6 7 an administrative law judge; or "(C) is made or taken to address an immediate 8 9 threat to health or safety that constitutes an emer-10 gency requiring an expedited response from the 11 Commission.". 12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by this section shall apply with respect to an order, decision, 13 report, or action made or taken after the date that is 90 14 15 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
