

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2666
OFFERED BY Ms . Matsui

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 3. RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.**

2 (a) **DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICES; UNFAIR BUSINESS**
3 **PRACTICES.**—Nothing in this Act shall be construed to af-
4 fect the authority of the Federal Communications Com-
5 mission to act in the public interest to regulate discrimina-
6 tory practices, or to prevent unfair business practices, by
7 providers of broadband Internet access service.

8 (b) **CONSUMER PROTECTIONS.**—Nothing in this Act
9 shall be construed to affect the authority of the Federal
10 Communications Commission to act in the public interest
11 to protect consumers or to regulate the billing practices
12 employed by, or the penalties or fees charged by, providers
13 of broadband Internet access service.

14 (c) **UNIVERSAL SERVICE.**—Nothing in this Act shall
15 be construed to affect the authority of the Federal Com-
16 munications Commission under section 214(e) or 254 of
17 the Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 214(e); 254).

18 (d) **OPEN INTERNET ORDER AND RULES.**—Nothing
19 in this Act shall be construed to affect the authority of
20 the Federal Communications Commission to enforce—

1 (1) the Report and Order on Remand, Declara-
2 tory Ruling, and Order that was adopted by the
3 Commission on February 26, 2015 (FCC 15–24); or

4 (2) the rules adopted in such Report and Order
5 on Remand, Declaratory Ruling, and Order.

6 (e) MERGER REVIEW.—Nothing in this Act shall be
7 construed to affect the authority of the Federal Commu-
8 nications Commission under subsection (a), (b), or (c) of
9 section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934 (47
10 U.S.C. 214) or section 310(d) of such Act (47 U.S.C.
11 310(d)).

12 (f) PAID PRIORITIZATION.—Nothing in this Act shall
13 be construed to affect the authority of the Federal Com-
14 munications Commission to enforce section 8.9 of title 47,
15 Code of Federal Regulations (or any successor regulation).

16 (g) BROADBAND INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE DE-
17 FINED.—In this section, the term “broadband Internet ac-
18 cess service” has the meaning given such term in the rules
19 adopted in the Report and Order on Remand, Declaratory
20 Ruling, and Order that was adopted by the Commission
21 on February 26, 2015 (FCC 15–24).
