4	to Congress a report describing the results of the
5	study, including the findings of the peer review

7	(4) REGULATIONS AND GUIDANCE.—The Ad-
8	ministrator shall incorporate the results of the
9	study, including the findings of the peer review
10	panel, into any Federal rules and guidance imple-
11	menting the 2015 ozone standards.

12 (3) Highly influential scientific assess-MENT.—The term "highly influential scientific as-13 sessment" means a highly influential scientific as-14 15 sessment as defined in the publication of the Office of Management and Budget entitled "Final Informa-16 tion Quality Bulletin for Peer Review' (70 Fed. 17 Reg. 2664 (January 14, 2005)). 18
