16	Insurance.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this
17	title, none of the provisions of this title (including amend-
18	ments made by such provisions) shall affect the require-
19	ment under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care
20	Act for a group health plan and a health insurance issuer

- 5 (d) Assuring No Lifetime Caps on Private In-
- 6 SURANCE POLICIES.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 7 sion of this title, none of the provisions of this title (includ-
- 8 ing amendments made by such provisions) shall affect the
- 9 prohibition under the Patient Protection and Affordable
- 10 Care Act that a group health plan and health insurance
- 11 issuer offering group or individual health insurance cov-
- 12 erage may not establish lifetime limits on the dollar value
- 13 of benefits for any participant or beneficiary of such plan
- 14 or coverage.
