## 1SEC. 3. EXCEPTION TO ENHANCEMENT TO TRANSPARENCY2REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO PERFORM-3ANCE CHARACTERISTICS AND NETWORK4PRACTICES FOR SMALL BUSINESSES.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The enhancements to the trans-6 parency rule relating to performance characteristics and network practices of the Commission under section 8.3 of 7 title 47, Code of Federal Regulations, as described in 8 paragraphs 165 through 184 of the Report and Order on 9 10 Remand, Declaratory Ruling, and Order in the matter of 11 protecting and promoting the open internet that was 12 adopted by the Commission February 26, 2015 (FCC 15– 13 24), shall not apply to any small business.

(b) SUNSET.—Subsection (a) shall not have any force
or effect after the date that is 1 year after the date of
the enactment of this Act.

(c) REPORT BY FCC.—Not later than 180 days after
the date of the enactment of this Act, the Commission
shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

 report that contains the recommendations of the Commis sion (and data supporting such recommendations) regard ing—

6 (1) whether the exception provided by sub7 section (a) should be made permanent; and

9 business" for purposes of such exception should be
10 modified from the definition in subsection (d)(3).

11 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

(1) BROADBAND INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE.—
The term "broadband Internet access service" has
the meaning given such term in section 8.2 of title
47, Code of Federal Regulations.

16 (2) COMMISSION.—The term "Commission"
17 means the Federal Communications Commission.

(3) SMALL BUSINESS.—The term "small business" means any provider of broadband Internet access service that has not more than 100,000 subscribers aggregated over all the provider's affiliates.
