Add at the end of the bill the following (and update the table of contents accordingly):

6	(a) In General.—Section 1861 of the Social Secu-
7	rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x) is amended—
8	(1) in subsection (n), in the first sentence, by
9	inserting before the semicolon the following: "and in-
10	cludes lymphedema compression treatment items (as
11	defined in subsection (kkk))"; and
12	(2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
13	section:
14	"Lymphedema Compression Treatment Items
15	"(kkk) The term 'lymphedema compression treat-
16	ment items'—
17	"(1) means, with respect to an individual, com-
18	pression garments, devices, bandaging systems, com-
19	ponents, and supplies—

1	"(A) that are primarily and customarily
2	used in the medical treatment of lymphedema;
3	"(B) as prescribed by a physician (or a
4	physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or a
5	clinical nurse specialist (as those terms are de-
6	fined in section 1861(aa)(5)) to the extent au-
7	thorized under State law); and
8	"(C) which would not, other than under
9	subsection (s)(6), be included as medical and
10	other health services under this title; and
11	"(2) includes—
12	"(A) multilayer compression bandaging
13	systems;
14	"(B) custom or standard fit gradient com-
15	pression garments;
16	"(C) non-elastic and low-elastic compres-
17	sion garments and compression wraps and di-
18	rectional flow pads; and
19	"(D) any other compression garments,
20	bandaging systems, devices, and aids deter-
21	mined by the Secretary to be effective in the
22	prevention or treatment of lymphedema.".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall apply to lymphedema compression
- 3 treatment items furnished on or after January 1, 2021.
