BILL: **H.R. 5564**, the “Enhancing Broadcast Diversity and Inclusion by Verifying and Ensuring the Reporting required by Statute Is transpiring and Yielding Data Act” or the “Enhancing Broadcaster DIVERSITY Data Act”

AMENDMENT: An amendment to the Clarke amendment in the nature of a substitute, No. 1b, offered by Mr. Walberg of Michigan, to exempt broadcast stations and Multichannel Video Programming Distributors (MVPDs) with fewer than 10 employees from audit of EEO Data.

DISPOSITION: **NOT AGREED TO** by a roll call vote of 23 yeas to 29 nays.¹
