1	(i) the mounting or installation of an
2	eligible personal wireless service facility
3	with another eligible personal wireless serv-
4	ice facility that exists at the time at which

6	such mounting or installation is filed with

15	(3) ELIGIBLE PERSONAL WIRELESS SERVICE
16	FACILITY.—The term "eligible personal wireless
17	service facility" means any antenna, apparatus, or
18	transmitting device, and any equipment, switches,
19	wiring, cabling, power sources, shelters, or cabinets,
20	for the provision of a personal wireless service.
21	(4) Personal wireless services.—The term
22	"personal wireless services"—
23	(A) has the meaning given such term in
24	section $332(c)(7)(C)$ of the Communications
25	Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 332(c)(7)(C)); and

(B) also includes commercial mobile data
 service (as defined in section 6001 of the Mid dle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of
 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1401)).

5 (5) STATE.—The term "State" means the 50
6 States, the District of Columbia, the territories and
7 possessions of the United States, and each federally
8 recognized Indian Tribe.
