At the end of subtitle D, add the following new chapter:

1 CHAPTER 4—OTHER MATTER SEC. 3331. BARRIERS TO IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ONLINE 3 PORTAL FOR FORM 299. 4 (a) Definitions.—In this section: 5 (1)APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF CON-GRESS.—The term "appropriate committees of Con-6 7 gress" means— (A) the Committee on Energy and Com-8 9 merce of the House of Representatives; 10 (B) the Committee on Natural Resources 11 of the House of Representatives; 12 (C) the Committee on Commerce, Science, 13 and Transportation of the Senate; and 14 (D) the Committee on Environment and 15 Public Works of the Senate. (2) Assistant Secretary.—The term "Assist-16 ant Secretary' means the Assistant Secretary of 17 18 Commerce for Communications and Information.

1	(3) Communications facility.—The term
2	"communications facility" includes—
3	(A) any infrastructure, including any
4	transmitting device, tower, or support structure,
5	and any equipment, switch, wiring, cabling,
6	power source, shelter, or cabinet, associated
7	with the licensed or permitted unlicensed wire-
8	less or wireline transmission of any writing,
9	sign, signal, data, image, picture, and sound of
10	any kind; and
11	(B) any antenna or apparatus that—
12	(i) is designed for the purpose of
13	emitting radio frequency;
14	(ii) is designed to be operated, or is
15	operating, from a fixed location pursuant
16	to authorization by the Commission or is
17	using a duly authorized device that does
18	not require an individual license; and
19	(iii) is added to a tower, building, or
20	other structure.
21	(4) Communications use.—The term "com-
22	munications use" means the placement and oper-
23	ation of a communications facility.
24	(5) Communications use authorization.—
25	The term "communications use authorization"

1	means an easement, right-of-way, lease, license, or
2	other authorization to locate or modify a commu-
3	nications facility on covered land by the Department
4	concerned for the primary purpose of authorizing
5	the occupancy and use of the covered land for com-
6	munications use.
7	(6) COVERED LAND.—The term "covered land"
8	means—
9	(A) public land administered by the Sec-
10	retary of the Interior; and
11	(B) National Forest System land.
12	(7) DEPARTMENT CONCERNED.—The term
13	"Department concerned" means the Department of
14	the Interior or the Department of Agriculture.
15	(8) Form 299.—The term "Form 299" means
16	the form established under section $6409(b)(2)(A)$ of
17	the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act
18	of 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1455(b)(2)(A)), or any successor
19	form.
20	(9) Secretary concerned.—The term "Sec-
21	retary concerned" means—
22	(A) the Secretary of the Interior, with re-
23	spect to land administered by such Secretary;
24	and

1	(B) the Secretary of Agriculture, with re-
2	spect to National Forest System land.
3	(b) Barriers to Implementation.—
4	(1) In general.—Not later than 90 days after
5	the date of enactment of this section, and every 60
6	days thereafter until the notification described in
7	paragraph (2), the Assistant Secretary shall submit
8	to the appropriate committees in Congress a report
9	that—
10	(A) describes whether the Department con-
11	cerned has established an online portal for the
12	acceptance, processing, and disposal of a Form
13	299; and
14	(B) describes any barrier to the establish-
15	ment of an online portal for the acceptance,
16	processing, and disposal of a Form 299.
17	(2) Notification described.—The Secretary
18	concerned shall notify the Assistant Secretary not
19	later than 3 business days after the Department
20	concerned has established an online portal for the
21	acceptance, processing, and disposal of a Form 299.
