4 (a) REGULATIONS REQUIRED.—The Commission 5 shall use support from amounts made available from the 6 Emergency Connectivity Fund, established under sub-7 section (b) for purposes of carrying out section 254(h) of 8 the Communications Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254(h)) and 9 its existing regulations for an eligible school or library.

10 (b) Emergency Connectivity Fund.—

(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in
the Treasury of the United States a fund to be
known as the "Emergency Connectivity Fund".

(2) APPROPRIATION.—There is appropriated to
the Emergency Connectivity Fund for fiscal year
2021, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated—
