Before section 1 of the bill, insert the following:

1           **DIVISION A—CONSUMER**  
2           **PROTECTION AND RECOVERY**

In section 1, strike “This Act” and insert “This division”.

At the end of the bill, insert the following:

3           **DIVISION B—FEDERAL TRADE**  
4           **COMMISSION EMPOWERMENT**  
5           **AND COVID–19 RESTITUTION**  
6           **FUND**

7           **SEC. 11. SHORT TITLE.**

8           This division may be cited as the “Federal Trade  
9 Commission Empowerment and COVID–19 Restitution  
10 Fund Act of 2021”.

11          **SEC. 12. TRANSFER.**

12          Notwithstanding any other provision of law and not  
13 later than December 31, 2022, the Administrator of Gen-  
14 eral Services shall transfer administrative jurisdiction,  
15 custody, and control of the building located at 600 Penn-

1 sylvania Avenue, NW., District of Columbia, to the Na-  
2 tional Gallery of Art for the purpose of housing and exhib-  
3 iting works of art and to carry out administrative func-  
4 tions and other activities related to the mission of the Na-  
5 tional Gallery of Art.

6 **SEC. 13. REMODELING, RENOVATING, OR RECON-**  
7 **STRUCTING.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The National Gallery of Art shall  
9 pay for the costs of remodeling, renovating, or recon-  
10 structing the building referred to in section 12.

11 (b) FEDERAL SHARE.—No appropriated funds may  
12 be used for the initial costs for the remodeling, renovating,  
13 or reconstructing of the building referred to in section 12.

14 (c) PROHIBITION.—The National Gallery of Art may  
15 not use sale, lease, or exchange, including leaseback ar-  
16 rangements, for the purposes of remodeling, renovating,  
17 or reconstructing the building referred to in section 12.

18 **SEC. 14. RELOCATION OF THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMIS-**  
19 **SION.**

20 (a) RELOCATION.—Not later than the date specified  
21 in section 12, the Administrator of General Services shall  
22 relocate the Federal Trade Commission housed in the  
23 building identified in section 12 to such other building in  
24 the District of Columbia owned by the Government that

1 the Administrator of General Services considers appro-  
2 priate.

3 (b) RENT.—The rental rate applied to the Federal  
4 Trade Commission by the Administrator of the General  
5 Services for use of the building identified in section 12  
6 as of the date of enactment of this Act shall apply to re-  
7 placement space provided by the Administrator pursuant  
8 to subsection (a) for 10 years after the relocation of such  
9 Commission.

10 **SEC. 15. NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART.**

11 Beginning on the date that the National Gallery of  
12 Art occupies the building referred to in section 12—

13 (1) the building shall be known and designated  
14 as the “North Building of the National Gallery of  
15 Art”; and

16 (2) any reference in a law, map, regulation,  
17 document, paper, or other record of the United  
18 States to the building shall be deemed to be a ref-  
19 erence to the “North Building of the National Gal-  
20 lery of Art”.

21 **SEC. 16. SAVINGS.**

22 All savings under this division shall be placed in a  
23 restitution fund for victims of unfair or deceptive acts or  
24 practices related to the COVID–19 pandemic, including

1 scams related to the treatment, cure, prevention, mitiga-  
2 tion, or diagnosis of COVID–19.
