not apply with respect to a notice described in paragraph (1) that is related to the manufacture of a seal, hose, o-ring, gasket, or other pipeline safety equipment, that is required to meet minimum safety standards for pipeline facilities under chapter 601 of title 49, United States Code.".

Section 8(b) is amended by adding at the end the following: "In revising such list, the Administrator shall exclude from any category or subcategory so listed a source whose emissions of such a substance are related to the manufacture of a seal, hose, o-ring, gasket, or other pipeline safety equipment, that is required to meet minimum safety standards for pipeline facilities under chapter 601 of title 49, United States Code."

Page 26, after line 13, insert the following:

7 "(3) Exemption.—Paragraph (1)(C) shall not 8 apply with respect to a seal, hose, o-ring, gasket, or 9 other pipeline safety equipment, containing 10 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, that is 11 required to meet minimum safety standards for pipe-12 line facilities under chapter 601 of title 49, United 13 States Code.".
