

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NA-
TURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO THE COMMITTEE
PRINT FOR H.R. 3291
OFFERED BY MR. O’HALLERAN OF ARIZONA**

At the end of title I, add the following:

1 **SEC. 114. INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE SANITATION FACILI-**
2 **TIES CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FUNDING.**

3 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—

4 (1) the COVID–19 crisis has highlighted the
5 lack of infrastructure and sanitation available in Na-
6 tive communities; and

7 (2) addressing the Sanitation Facilities Defi-
8 ciency List of the Division of Sanitation Facilities
9 and Construction of the Indian Health Service in-
10 cluded in the report will—

11 (A) result in investments in necessary
12 water infrastructure; and

13 (B) improve health outcomes.

14 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

15 (1) REPORT.—The term “report” means the
16 fiscal year 2019 report of the Division of Sanitation
17 Facilities and Construction of the Indian Health
18 Service entitled “Annual Report to the Congress of

1 the United States on Sanitation Deficiency Levels
2 for Indian Homes and Communities”.

3 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
4 the Secretary of Health and Human Services, acting
5 through the Director of the Indian Health Service.

6 (c) ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR SANITATION FACILI-
7 TIES.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall award
9 additional funding under the Sanitation Facilities
10 Construction Program for the planning, design, con-
11 struction, modernization, improvement, and renova-
12 tion of water, sewer, and solid waste sanitation fa-
13 cilities that are funded, in whole or part, by the In-
14 dian Health Service through, or provided for in, a
15 contract or compact with the Indian Health Service
16 under the Indian Self-Determination and Education
17 Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.).

18 (2) PRIORITY FOR FUNDING.—In awarding
19 funding to sanitation facilities under paragraph (1),
20 the Secretary shall prioritize sanitation facilities
21 with the highest deficiency level, as established in
22 the report.

23 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be
2 appropriated to the Secretary to carry out this sec-
3 tion \$2,600,000,000.

4 (2) REQUIREMENT.—Amounts made available
5 under paragraph (1) shall be in addition to any
6 amounts made available to carry out the purposes
7 described in subsection (c)(1) under any other provi-
8 sion of law.
