## A BILL

To designate methamphetamine as an emerging threat, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Methamphetamine Re-  
5 sponse Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. DECLARATION OF EMERGING THREAT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Congress declares methamphet-  
8 amine an emerging drug threat, as defined in section 702  
9 of the Office of National Drug Control Policy Reauthor-

1 ization Act of 1998 (21 U.S.C. 1701), in the United  
2 States.

3 (b) REQUIRED EMERGING THREAT RESPONSE  
4 PLAN.—Not later than 90 days after the date of enact-  
5 ment of this Act, the Director of the Office of National  
6 Drug Control Policy shall establish and implement an  
7 Emerging Threat Response Plan that is specific to meth-  
8 amphetamine in accordance with section 709(d) of the Of-  
9 fice of National Drug Control Policy Reauthorization Act  
10 of 1998 (21 U.S.C. 1708(d)).
