In section 31031, add at the end the following:

1	(e) RISK FRAMEWORK.—Not later than 1 year after
2	the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall en-
3	sure that the National Institutes of Health and other rel-
4	evant agencies and offices within the Department of
5	Health and Human Services, working with the heads of
6	agencies and national security experts, including the Of-
7	fice of the National Security within the Department of
8	Health and Human Services—
9	(1) develop a comprehensive framework for as-
10	sessing and managing national security risks re-
11	ferred to in subsection (a) that includes—
12	(A) criteria for how and when to conduct
13	risk assessments for projects that may have na-
14	tional security implications;
15	(B) security controls and training for re-
16	searchers or entities, including peer reviewers,
17	that manage or have access to such data; and

1	(C) methods to incorporate risk-reduction
2	in the process for funding such projects that
3	may have national security implications;
4	(2) not later than 1 year after the risk frame-
5	work is developed under paragraph (1), develop and
6	implement controls to—
7	(A) ensure that researchers or entities that
8	manage or have access to such data have com-
9	plied with the requirements of paragraph (1)
10	and ongoing requirements with such paragraph;
11	and
12	(B) ensure that data access committees re-
13	viewing data access requests for projects that
14	may have national security risks, as appro-
15	priate, include members with expertise in cur-
16	rent and emerging national security threats, in
17	order to make appropriate decisions related to
18	access to such identifiable, sensitive informa-
19	tion; and
20	(3) not later than 2 years after the risk frame-
21	work is developed under paragraph (1), update data
22	access and sharing policies related to human
23	genomic data, as appropriate, based on current and
24	emerging national security threats.
