12	NATION.—A reason for a suspension or termination
13	of a Federal award described in this paragraph is a

18 (B) a Federal law or regulation; or

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(C) a request by the Secretary awarding

4 (3) LIST OF SUSPENSIONS.—The Director of
5 the Office of Management and Budget shall main6 tain an up-to-date list of suspended entities that is
7 available to the public.

8 (b) EFFECT ON OTHER GRANTS.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may not 10 award an award or disburse funds under a award to 11 a suspended entity until the date on which the sus-12 pended entity remedies the reason for a suspension 13 or termination of a Federal award of the suspended 14 entity under subsection (a)(2).

(2) COMPLIANCE.—For the purpose of complying with paragraph (1), the Secretary shall reference the list of suspended entities maintained by
the Director of the Office of Management and Budget under subsection (a)(3).

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
