Amend section 31056 to read as follows:

1	SEC. 31056. FUNDING FOR ANTIDISCRIMINATION AND BIAS
2	TRAINING.
3	(a) In General.—In addition to amounts otherwise
4	available, there is appropriated to the Secretary for fiscal
5	year 2022, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise
6	appropriated, \$25,000,000, to remain available until ex-
7	pended, for the purpose described in subsection (b).
8	(b) USE OF FUNDS.—The Secretary shall use
9	amounts appropriated under subsection (a) to award com-
10	petitive grants or contracts to national nonprofit organiza-
11	tions focused on improving health equity (including for in-
12	fants who survive an attempted abortion), accredited
13	schools of medicine or nursing, and other health profes-
14	sional training programs to develop, disseminate, review,
15	research, and evaluate training for health professionals
16	and all staff who interact with patients to reduce discrimi-
17	nation and bias (including discrimination and bias toward

1	infants who survive an attempted abortion) in the provi-
2	sion of health care.
3	(c) Rule of Construction Regarding Infants
4	WHO SURVIVE AN ATTEMPTED ABORTION.—Activities to
5	reduce discrimination and bias toward infants who survive
6	an attempted abortion under (b) shall include training
7	that—
8	(1) an infant born alive after an attempted
9	abortion is entitled to the same degree of profes-
10	sional skill, care, and diligence to preserve the life
11	and health of the child as a reasonably diligent and
12	conscientious health care provider would render to
13	any other infant born alive at the same gestational
14	age; and
15	(2) following the exercise of skill, care, and dili-
16	gence the infant is entitled to, the infant receives
17	immediate transport and admission to a hospital.
