13	(2) Powers of the federal trade commis-

15	(A) IN GENERAL.—The Federal Trade
16	Commission shall enforce this section in the
17	same manner, by the same means, and with the

1	same jurisdiction, powers, and duties as though
2	all applicable terms and provisions of the Fed-
3	eral Trade Commission Act (15 U.S.C. 41 et
4	seq.) were incorporated into and made a part of
5	this section.
6	(B) Privileges and immunities.—Any
7	person that violates this section shall be subject
8	to the penalties and entitled to the privileges
9	and immunities provided in the Federal Trade
10	Commission act.
11	(C) Preservation of ftc authority.—
12	Nothing in this section shall be construed to
13	limit the authority of the Federal Trade Com-
14	mission under any other provision of law.
