Subtitle D—Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Parity Implementation

4 SEC. 331. GRANTS TO SUPPORT MENTAL HEALTH AND SUB5 STANCE USE DISORDER PARITY IMPLEMEN6 TATION.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2794(c) of the Public
8 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg-94(c)) (as added by
9 section 1003 of the Patient Protection and Affordable
10 Care Act (Public Law 111-148)) is amended by adding
11 at the end the following:

12 "(3) PARITY IMPLEMENTATION.—

"(A) IN GENERAL.—Beginning during the
first fiscal year that begins after the date of enactment of this paragraph, the Secretary shall,
out of funds made available pursuant to subparagraph (C), award grants to eligible States
to enforce and ensure compliance with the men-

3	"(B) ELIGIBLE STATE.—A State shall be
4	eligible for a grant awarded under this para-
5	graph only if such State—
6	"(i) submits to the Secretary an appli-

10	"(ii) agrees to request and review
11	from health insurance issuers offering

20	"(C) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-
21	TIONS.—There are authorized to be appro-

until expended, for purposes of awarding grants
 under subparagraph (A).".
