

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7666**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CURTIS OF UTAH**

Page 122, line 19, strike the end quotation marks and the second period.

Page 122, after line 19, insert the following:

1                   “(iii)   CONDITIONAL   IMPLEMENTA-  
2                   TION.—For the purposes of sunseting  
3                   election options under this subparagraph,  
4                   the elimination of the opt-out for non-  
5                   federal governmental health plans shall not  
6                   be permitted until the Secretary, in con-  
7                   sultation with the Secretary of Labor and  
8                   the Secretary of the Treasury, establishes  
9                   through rulemaking a defined set of non-  
10                  quantitative treatment limitations (referred  
11                  to in this section as ‘NQTLs’) on mental  
12                  health or substance use disorder benefits,  
13                  comprehensive model or sample analyses  
14                  that demonstrate compliance across the  
15                  different types of NQTLs, de-identified ex-  
16                  amples of compliant NQTLs, a process and  
17                  timeline for the 45-day corrective action

1 period, and standards for aligning federal  
2 and state parity investigations for the pur-  
3 poses of enforcing section 2726, section  
4 712 of the Employee Retirement Income  
5 Security Act of 1974, and section 9812 of  
6 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.”
