

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 8152  
OFFERED BY MS. ESHOO OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 126, line 15, strike “PREEMPTION” and insert  
“PRESERVATION”.

Page 126, strike line 16 and all that follows through  
page 129, line 18, and insert the following (and redesignate the succeeding paragraphs accordingly):

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—This Act, and any amend-  
2           ment, standard, rule, requirement, assessment, or  
3           regulation promulgated under this Act, does not  
4           annul, alter, affect, or exempt any person subject to  
5           the provisions of this Act from complying with the  
6           laws of any State or political subdivision of a State  
7           with respect to privacy or consumer protection, ex-  
8           cept to the extent that those laws are inconsistent  
9           with any provisions of this Act, and then only to the  
10          extent of the inconsistency. For purposes of this  
11          paragraph, a law of a State or political subdivision  
12          of a State is not inconsistent with this Act if the

1 protection such law affords any consumer is greater  
2 than the protection provided by this Act.
