SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 2 This Act may be cited as the "Sickle Cell Disease 3 and Other Heritable Blood Disorders Research, Surveil-4 lance, Prevention, and Treatment Act of 2023". 5 SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF SICKLE CELL DISEASE AND 6 OTHER HERITABLE BLOOD DISORDERS RE-7 SEARCH, SURVEILLANCE, PREVENTION, AND 8 TREATMENT. 9 Section 1106(b) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300b–5(b)) is amended— 10 11 (1) in paragraph (3)(A), by inserting ", grant, or cooperative agreement" after "contract"; and 12 (2) in paragraph (6), by striking "\$4,455,000 13 14 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023" and in-

serting "\$8,205,000 for each of fiscal years 2024

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through 2028".
