AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7655

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Add at the end the following:

1 SEC. 23. GEOHAZARD MITIGATION STUDY.

2	(a) In General.—Not later than 1 year after the
3	date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
4	of the United States shall prepare a report containing—
5	(1) the results of a study that—
6	(A) evaluates Federal and State require-
7	ments, as applicable, for gas, hazardous liquid,
8	and carbon dioxide pipeline facility design,
9	siting, construction, operation and maintenance,
10	and integrity management relating to
11	geohazards, including seismicity, land subsid-
12	ence, landslides, slope instability, frost heave,
13	soil settlement, erosion, river scour, washouts,
14	floods, unstable soil, water currents, hurricanes,
15	dynamic geologic conditions, tsunamis, tor-
16	nados, wildfires, floods, ice storms, or other
17	hazards that may cause a pipeline to move or
18	be affected by abnormal external loads;

1	(B) evaluates any industry consensus
2	standards or best practices related to the re-
3	quirements described in subparagraph (A);
4	(C) evaluates—
5	(i) the implementation by operators of
6	Federal and State regulations related to
7	geohazards; and
8	(ii) the application of recommenda-
9	tions included in the Advisory Bulletin of
10	the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials
11	Safety Administration titled "Pipeline
12	Safety: Potential for Damage to Pipeline
13	Facilities Caused by Earth Movement and
14	Other Geological Hazards", issued on May
15	2, 2019 (84 Fed. Reg. 18919; PHMSA-
16	019–0087);
17	(D) identifies any discrepancies in—
18	(i) the requirements described in sub-
19	paragraph (A); and
20	(ii) the advisories, industry consensus
21	standards, or best practices for operators
22	of gas, hazardous liquid, and carbon diox-
23	ide pipeline facilities; and

1	(E) identifies any areas relating to
2	geohazards not addressed under subparagraphs
3	(A) through (D); and
4	(2) any recommendations of the Government
5	Accountability Office based on the results of the
6	study under paragraph (1).
7	(b) Report to Congress.—Upon completion of the
8	report under subsection (a), the Comptroller General shall
9	submit to the Secretary of Transportation, the Committee
10	on Transportation and Infrastructure and the Committee
11	on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representa-
12	tives, and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
13	Transportation of the Senate the report.
