## A BILL

To require an annual budget estimate for the initiatives of the National Institutes of Health pursuant to reports and recommendations made under the National Alzheimer’s Project Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Alzheimer’s Account-  
5 ability and Investment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROJECT.**

7 Section 2 of the National Alzheimer’s Project Act (42  
8 U.S.C. 11225) is amended—

1           (1) by redesignating subsection (h) as sub-  
2           section (i); and

3           (2) by inserting after subsection (g) the fol-  
4           lowing:

5           “(h) PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT BUDGET.—For fis-  
6           cal year 2024 and each subsequent fiscal year, the Direc-  
7           tor of the National Institutes of Health shall prepare and  
8           submit, directly to the President for review and trans-  
9           mittal to Congress, after reasonable opportunity for com-  
10          ment, but without change, by the Secretary of Health and  
11          Human Services and the Advisory Council, an annual  
12          budget estimate for the initiatives of the National Insti-  
13          tutes of Health pursuant to the reports and recommenda-  
14          tions made under this Act, including an estimate of the  
15          number and type of personnel needs for the National In-  
16          stitutes of Health.”.
