To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to further
require certain additional provider screening under the
Medicaid program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MEDICAID PROVIDER SCREENING REQUIRE-**

4 **MENTS.**

5 Section 1902(kk)(1) of the Social Security Act (42

6 U.S.C. 1396a(kk)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “The State” and inserting:

1 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The State”; and

2 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
3 paragraph:

4 “(B) ADDITIONAL PROVIDER SCREEN-
5 ING.—Beginning January 1, 2027, as part of
6 the enrollment (or reenrollment or revalidation
7 of enrollment) of a provider or supplier under
8 this title, and not less frequently than quarterly
9 during the period that such provider or supplier
10 is so enrolled, the State conducts a check of any
11 database or similar system developed pursuant
12 to section 6401(b)(2) of the Patient Protection
13 and Affordable Care Act to determine whether
14 the Secretary has terminated the participation
15 of such provider or supplier under title XVIII,
16 or whether any other State has terminated the
17 participation of such provider or supplier under
18 such other State’s State plan under this title
19 (or waiver of the plan), or such other State’s
20 State child health plan under title XXI (or
21 waiver of the plan).”.
