

1 (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.) (or a waiver of such plan)
2 based on a qualifying disability, including—

3 (A) general information about eligibility
4 under subclauses (XIII), (XV), (XVI), and
5 (XIX) of section 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii) of the So-
6 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 1396a(a)(10)(A)(ii));

8 (B) which States offer Medicaid buy-in
9 programs; and

10 (C) the specific eligibility requirements of
11 each such program;

12 (2) information about how to contact each
13 State’s Medicaid office for information about Med-
14 icaid and Children’s Health Insurance Program eli-
15 gibility, including links and phone numbers for State
16 contacts;

17 (3) information on Medicaid-covered long-term
18 services and supports available to individuals eligible
19 for medical assistance under a State plan under the
20 Medicaid program under title XIX of the Social Se-
21 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.) (or a waiver of
22 such plan); and

23 (4) where applicable, the duration of wait lists
24 to receive the services described in paragraph (3).

1 (b) PROMOTION.—The Secretary shall, as applicable
2 and appropriate, identify and disseminate promotional ac-
3 tivities to improve, among people with a disability and the
4 caretakers and families of such people, the awareness of
5 the resources included in the website established under
6 subsection (a), such as through collaboration with the So-
7 cial Security Administration during its annual updates to
8 the Red Book.

9 (c) MODEL.—In establishing the website under this
10 section, the Secretary may use the website
11 thinkdifferently.net as a model.

12 (d) NONAPPLICATION OF PAPERWORK REDUCTION
13 ACT.—Chapter 35 of title 44, United States Code (com-
14 monly referred to as the “Paperwork Reduction Act of
15 1995”), shall not apply to the implementation of this sec-
16 tion.

Amend the title to read as follows: “A Bill to direct
the Secretary of Health and Human Services to establish
a website to promote awareness of available resources for
individuals with disabilities, and for other purposes.”.
