3	tion Act is amended by inserting after section 163 (42
4	U.S.C. 6243) the following:
5	"SEC. 164. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN EXPORTS.
6	"(a) In General.—The Secretary shall prohibit the
7	export or sale of petroleum products drawn down from the
8	Strategic Petroleum Reserve, under any provision of law,
9	to—
10	"(1) the People's Republic of China;
11	"(2) the Democratic People's Republic of
12	Korea;
13	"(3) the Russian Federation;
14	"(4) the Islamic Republic of Iran; and
15	"(5) any entity that is under the ownership or
16	control of—
17	"(A) a country referred to in any of para-
18	graphs (1) through (4); or
19	"(B) the Chinese Communist Party.

1	"(b) Waiver.—The Secretary may issue a waiver of
2	the prohibition described in subsection (a) if the Secretary
3	certifies that any export or sale authorized pursuant to
4	the waiver is in the national security interests of the
5	United States.
6	"(c) Rule.—Not later than 60 days after the date
7	of enactment of this subsection, the Secretary shall issue
8	a rule to carry out this section.".
9	(b) Conforming Amendments.—
10	(1) Drawdown and sale of Petroleum
11	PRODUCTS.—Section 161(a) of the Energy Policy
12	and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6241(a)) is
